## *Bolen & Martin take 7<sup>th</sup>*



Havana, Cuba - **Brad Bolen** (25) and **Hannah Martin** (25) from the Jason Morris Judo Center (JMJC) in Glenville, NY both placed seventh in their respective divisions at the International Judo Federation's (IJF) Grand Prix event in Havana, Cuba, June 7, 2014. They both earned 48 points for their effort on the IJF's world ranking list which 24 will directly count toward the Olympic qualification for Rio, Bolen in 66kg and Martin in 63kg.

"This is a good start for both athletes in the qualification process for the Brazil Olympics" their coach and 4x Olympian, Jason Morris said. Burnt Hills High School graduate, Martin's injured knee held up well against the very top competition in 63kg. Martin's Losses were to #2 and eventual champion, Clarisse Agbegnenou (France) and #10 Maricet Espinoza (Cuba) who ended up with a bronze medal defeating world champ, Yarden Gerbi (Israel). JMJC's **Nick Kossor** (28) lost his opening match yesterday in 60kg to Juan Perez (Chile) and was eliminated. "They gained a ton of valuable experience and confidence from this event. I am very pleased with their progress." Morris continued.

## JMJC Trio Take Fifth



San Salvador, El Salvador - Athlete's from the Jason Morris Judo Center (JMJC) fared very well at the San Salvador World Judo Cup in El Salvador on June 14<sup>th</sup>, as three were in the medal rounds and two placed seventh.

Burnt Hills High School graduate, **Nick Kossor** (28) placed fifth in 60kg earning more valuable points toward the Olympic qualifying. Among Kossor's wins was one over Juan Perez (Chile) who eliminated him last week in Cuba. **Brad Bolen** (25) also placed fifth at 66kg to raise his world ranking to #33. Burnt Hills graduate, **Hannah Martin** was the third JMJC athlete to place fifth as she did so in 63kg. Martin lost a heartbreaker in the semis to longtime nemesis and eventual champ Hilde Drexler (Austria) in an overtime thriller. SCCC student, **Alex Turner** (21) continued to improve as he placed seventh in 73kg and bumped his ranking 8 slots from #180 to #172 in the world. **Ashley Hejlik** (27) placed seventh at only her second world cup and debuts on the world ranking list at #125. SCCC student, **Maria Dhami** (18) was ousted in the first round in 52kg by veteran Lisa Kearny (Ireland) and eliminated.
